Bryce, a former member of St. Andrew's and one of the first non-indigenous people to speak out against the Residential School System over one hundred years ago. The discussion will be moderated by CVC TV news anchor, Adrian Harewood. The launch and reception begins at 6pm, followed by the panel discussion at 7pm. All events are free of charge.
