He specializes in the treatment of lung cancer and is active in lung cancer advocacy, currently serving as President of Lung Cancer Canada, a national charity supporting patient and caregivers' lung cancer, and promoting advocacy and research. He is also the Deputy Division Head of Medical Oncology, the Board President at his children's school, a runner, a soccer coach and an amateur history enthusiast. Paul and his wife, Alison, attend St. Paul's Presbyterian Church in Ottawa, where Alison is also an elder and member of the Missions committee.
