CAFÉ CONNECTIONS VOLUNTEERS NEEDED: To be successful, this endeavour needs your help. We need people to volunteer to host these weekly get togethers. Volunteers will set up tables and chairs, make and serve coffee and tea and cookies, socialise with clients and then clean up. All supplies will be provided. RE-FLOORING FUNDRAISER: The Stewardship Committee is continuing its fundraising efforts for the re-flooring of the Main Hall floor, and the corridor floor between the Toddler Room and Washrooms. The quotations are in the total amount of approximately \$30,500, and this will be the Stewardship Committee's fundraising goal. Keep in mind that approximately \$10,000 has been donated already. The total cost including tax is comprised, in round figures, of \$14,500 for the controlled environmental removal of the tile, leveller and glue, all of which contain asbestos, plus \$16,000 for a new floor installation.

VISIT OF AMANDA CURRIE: On Saturday, September 21, 2019 at 7 p.m., St. Giles Church (at the corner of Bank Street and First Avenue) will host a visit from the Rev'd Amanda Currie, Moderator of the 145th General Assembly of The Presbyterian Church in Canada. Her presentation is entitled "The Scandal of Division and the Promise of Unity" and she will share about the scandal of the divided Body of Christ and the promise of unity in Christ through love. An open invitation is extended to members of the presbytery, to congregations within the presbytery, and to other local churches to attend. Amanda will also be preaching at St. Giles Church on Sunday, September 22, 2019 at 10:30 a.m. on the subject: "I Have Need of You".
