RE-FLOORING FUNDRAISER: The Stewardship Committee is continuing its fundraising efforts for the re-flooring of the Main Hall floor, and the corridor floor between the Toddler Room and Washrooms. The quotations are in the total amount of approximately \$30,500, and this will be the Stewardship Committee's fundraising goal. Keep in mind that approximately \$10,000 has been donated already. The total cost including tax is comprised, in round figures, of \$14,500 for the controlled environmental removal of tile, leveler and glue, all of which contain asbestos, plus \$16,000 for a new floor installation.
