Minister's Corner Do you use any products for skin renewal? Even if you don't, our human body is in a constant

state of regeneration and renewal, from the cells in our skeleton to the nails on our toes. Of course, it takes different timeframes for your body to regrow 19 different types of cells and organs, and some body parts never get replaced. But it is still a beautiful idea when you think about it: you can leave the old you behind and become almost completely new person every so many years. Wow!

But what about your truer self, I mean what about your inner being? The renewal of the inside is the work of the spirit. God renews us and makes us a new creation. According to the 2011 National Household Survey, about 22.1 million people, or just over two-thirds of the population in Canada, reported that they were affiliated with Christian religion. But what happens is that apathy sets in. We still have faith, but we feel uninterested, indifferent, unmoved, detached. Sometimes we <u>simply don't</u> <u>desire God</u>. Well, our God is a God of renewal. It's His heart for all of us, and He invites us to participate by opening ourselves, being available for His renewing work, and following the lead of the Spirit.
