COVID UPDATE

Despite new Omicron variants emerging at this time, as it is summer and ventilation can be maintained in church, it is felt that we can continue to worship in-person in the Sanctuary. Good advice on precautions to take was published recently in the Citizen (13 July 2022): "OPH (Ottawa Public Health) has advised residents to take precautions against the virus, including getting all vaccine shots for which they are eligible, staying home if they are sick and wearing masks in indoor public spaces and also outdoors in crowds, such as at festivals, if it's not possible to keep two metres of distance."
