HEFC WALKATHON: STEP UP and STEP OUT to STOP HUNGER: Saturday, September 23, 9-noon.

HEFC in collaboration with its volunteers and community churches is holding its annual fundraising walk in the Alta Vista neighbourhood, starting and finishing at St. Thomas Anglican Church, 2345 Alta Vista Drive. You can help by joining in the walk (an easy 4-5 km. walk, suitable for everyone), sponsoring a walker, or making a donation (www.hefc.ca). Posters are on the bulletin boards and more information can be obtained by phoning HEFC at 613-737-9090.

GARDENING FOR THE HERON EMERGENCY FOOD CENTRE: In addition to St. Timothy's generous year-round donations of non-perishable food items, the church is able to supplement contributions to the HEFC with fresh produce during the summer months. Since the church gardens began in 2016, at least one plot has been dedicated to HEFC each year. Many thanks to the volunteers who make it possible, from tilling to harvest. This year two full plots and part of another were planted with root vegetables and broccoli. Our deliveries so far have included beets, broccoli, onions and 120 pounds of potatoes. Carrots and more are yet to be harvested. Other St. Timothy's gardeners also share the bounty of their plots with the HEFC. Excess produce from your home garden would be welcome too. During opening hours, fresh food can be taken to the delivery window at the east side of the Centre, 1480 Heron Road. Food is distributed on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons, Wednesday evening, and Friday morning.
