Minister's Corner: A mission story

Stories of mission are stories of faith. They reveal how ordinary people, through words and actions, make an extraordinary impact. Like in Jesus' Parable of the Talents, these stories are less about success and more about faithfulness. The master commends the servant, saying: "Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things." (Matthew 25:23). Even in the master's absence, the servant fulfilled his duty with trust and devotion. One such story is that of Gladys Aylward (1902-1970). As a teenager, she read about China and felt called to share God's love. Rejected by missionary training school, she worked various jobs to fund her journey. At age 30, she left Liverpool and joined an elderly missionary, Mrs. Jeannie Lawson. Despite being told she could not learn the language, she did and began sharing the Gospel in villages. She took in orphans, caring for over 100 children. In 1938, when war threatened their lives, she led them on a 27-day journey to safety. Miraculously, not one child was lost. Reflecting on her life, she wrote: "My heart is full of praise that one so insignificant, uneducated, and ordinary could be used to His glory." Even when forced to leave China, she continued her mission in Hong Kong and Taipei. Gladys' story is not about being extraordinary but about faith in action. Today, countless individuals continue to bring Christ's Good News to the world. The call to mission is still alive. What about us? Are we willing to follow where Christ leads? May we, too, be found faithful in our mission, trusting that God will use our efforts for His glory.
